What to expect on Day 1

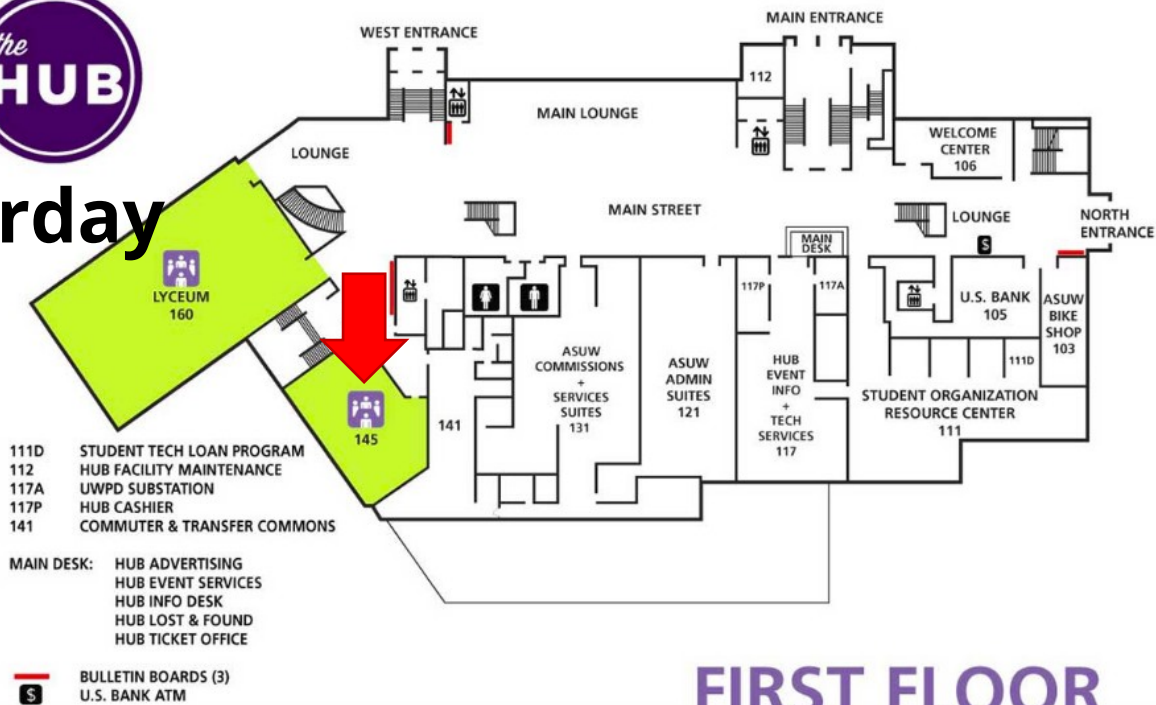
Lunchtime panels

Map of the HUB



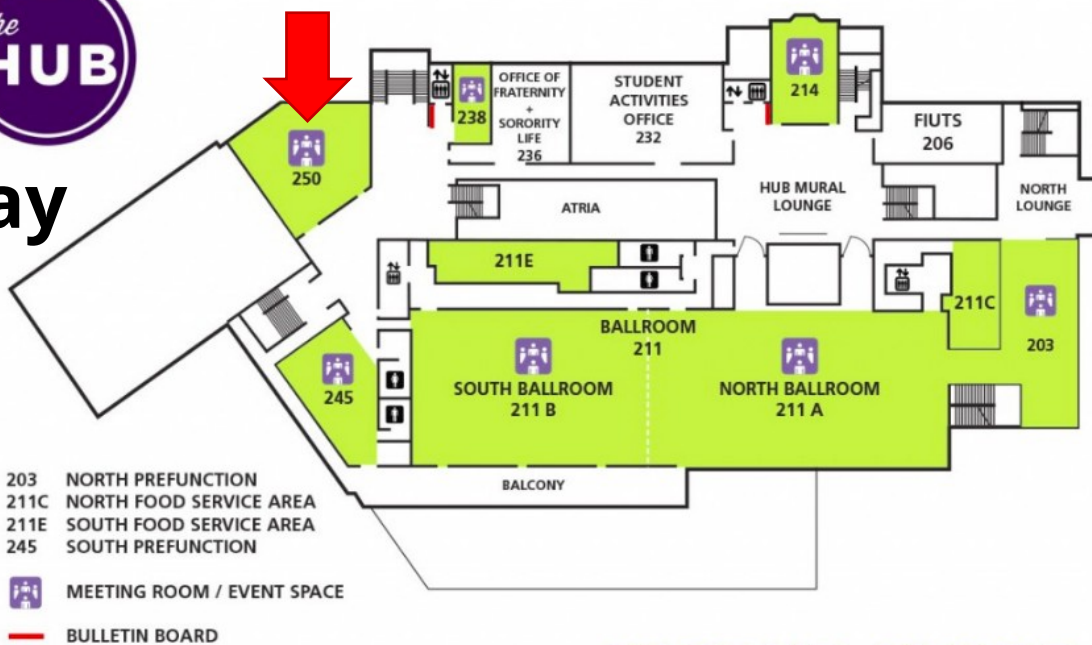
