

Thank you for your interest in volunteering at the School of Dentistry. Enclosed is the information on how to become a volunteer. You must complete and return the following forms:

- Volunteer Application
- Patient Confidentiality Agreement
- Criminal Background Check
- Immunization Clinic Referral

Volunteers at the School of Dentistry do not provide patient care for liability reasons. Volunteers may help out in the clinics by greeting and seating patients, preparing dental operatories for patients, delivering and picking up charts, calling patients, ordering supplies, and cutting and taping bags for clinic use.

To be considered as a volunteer, you must complete the above listed items and be cleared by the immunization clinic for work in patient care areas. You would be responsible for any immunizations required. Please be sure to call ahead to the immunization clinic (206-685-1018) to schedule an appointment and remember to bring your immunization records. A sheet detailing the immunization policy and required immunizations is included in this packet.
