#### **Requirements for Full Membership**

- 1. Completion of at least 5 quarters or 3 semesters at an accredited college or university.
- 2. Completion of at least 14 quarter credits of psychology.
- 3. Registration for major standing in psychology at UW.
- 4. Undergraduates must have an overall cumulative GPA of at least 3.20 (UW only) and a minimum GPA in psychology of 3.40 (UW only).

#### **Requirements for Associate Member \***

- 1. Associate members must be regularly enrolled as undergraduate students at UW and have completed at least one course psychology course at the UW.
- 2. Undergraduates who are elected to associate membership in Psi Chi must have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.20 (UW only).

\* Please note: As an associate member of Psi Chi at UW, you are not a member of National Psi Chi. Associate Membership at UW gives you the opportunity to take part in all Psi Chi activities at the UW. In the event that you should wish to apply for full membership at a later date, you will only need to pay the one time registration fee of \$35.00, which pays for national membership.

Membership in Psi Chi is open to qualified candidates of any age, sex, sexual orientation, race, handicap or disability, color, religion, and national or ethnic origins as outlined in the national by-laws and the University of Washington Student Handbook.

### **Application Process**

Complete the application form on back of this sheet and attach unofficial UW transcript with all psychology courses highlighted and GPA calculated. If applying for national membership, complete both registration cards. Sign application and submit by: Friday, November 5, 2004 at 5:00 pm to the Psi Chi mail box or the Psychology Advising Office in Guthrie Hall.

*If you are applying for national membership*, please include a personal check or money order for **\$55 payable to UW Psi Chi,** which will only be cashed upon acceptance. This one-time fee will cover both your national (\$35.00) and local dues (\$20.00) for active membership.

*If you are applying for local membership*, please include a personal check or money order for **\$20 payable to UW Psi Chi,** which will only be cashed upon acceptance. This yearly fee will cover your chapter dues for active associate membership.
