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Tossups

1. This character uses Augerin Canyon as a training site and obstacle course for new SEATs. This character's former role as an actor is hinted at by Cad Spinner when he is told he is "less famous" than the new arrival. This character's use of his (*) hoist is the subject of a drinking game by his colleagues. Prior to his current profession, this character starred on the TV show *CHoPs* alongside Nick "Loopin" Lopez. After saving Dusty's life on several occasions, this character crashes on takeoff, putting him out of action until reappearing during a climactic rescue at Whitewall Falls. For 10 points, name this Chief of Fire & Rescue at Piston Peak Air Attack. ANSWER: <u>Blade</u> Ranger [or Blazin' <u>Blade</u>] <Andrea>

2. This stud's middle name stands for both "Dangerous" and

"Dokonokuminomonjawaresumakinishiteshizumetarokakora." This stud killed his guardian at age 7 and then was raised by either the Eye of Michael in the manga or Chapel the Evergreen in the anime. ":)" ("colon closed-parenthesis") and "invisible to light mode" are known for fangirling over this stud in the (*) UW Bio Discord, including a gif of this stud kneeling with his signature weapon overlaid with the text "RIP BOZO." That gif is taken from the episode "Paradise," in which this stud ruminates over their sins in a church after telling their friend that Knives is in Demitrihi. The 60 Billion Dollar Man uses this stud's gun, "Punisher," to defeat Million Knives in the climax of this stud's 1998 anime adaptation. For 10 points, name this stud, who wields a giant cross shaped machine gun and is Vash's sidekick in the anime *Trigun*. ANSWER: Nicholas D. **Wolfwood** [accept **Woowoo**]

3. In order to avoid broadcasting restrictions, a song addressed to this character includes the repeated line "You make me complete," with heavy emphasis on the first syllable of "complete." In one scene, this character describes herself and her girlfriend as "lesbian, gay-type lovers" when asked about their relationship. This (*) nerd's first partner was portrayed by Seth Green, and her last partner may be the most hated character in the series. This character repeats the line "Bored now" before flaying a man alive and then incinerating him. For 10 points, Sarah Palin probably didn't name her daughter after what redheaded witch portrayed by Alyson Hannigan in *Buffy the Vampire Slayer*?

ANSWER: <u>Willow</u> Rosenberg <Sonya>

4. A character in a movie played by this actor was rumored to have had sex with a robot. In another TV show with this actor, the character he plays screams in agony when he meets actor LeVar Burton instead of getting

a signed photo of actor LeVar Burton. This actor is also an accomplished (*) comedian and singer/songwriter. In his first EP, he sings the lyric "E.e. Cummin' on her face, now that's poetry in motion." In a song about infinity, this person raps he has a stripper similar to a certain Palestinian exclave. Recently, this actor played Aaron Davis in a *Spiderman* movie. For 10 points, name this African-American actor whose stage name is Childish Gambino. ANSWER: Donald <u>Glover</u> [prompt on <u>Childish Gambino</u>]

5. One character with this name was formerly assigned to task force MTF Omega 7 "Pandora's Box" alongside SCP-076-2 "Able" after beating him in a challenge using her reality-bending abilities. A Greek goddess with this name was born to Thaumas and Electra and serves as Hera's personal handmaiden and messenger. A guest party member in *Final Fantasy XV* with an unusual pronunciation of this name is the (*) younger sister of Gladiolus Amicitia. Another character with this name was born and raised in the Village of Dragons and is the only one of Ash Ketchum's companions to become a Champion. That character is fought in Opelucid City in *Pokémon White*, and her pokemon include Druddigon and Haxorus. For 10 points, give the name of the Greek goddess of the rainbow, which can also refer to an anatomical structure surrounding the pupil. ANSWER: Iris (the characters mentioned are Iris Thompson from SCP 105, Iris Amicitia from Final Fantasy XV, and Iris from *Pokémon*) <Ali>

6. This person wrote the lyrics "You were the sun / On the wave / Come daylight" in a song written about a woman who they wed several years later. That song written by this person, "ohNadine (You Were in My Dream)," appears on their only released album, 2014's True That. A former costar once described this person as a "weird little freak" when recounting how the two of them were nearly (*) married in Vegas. That person is Aubrey Plaza. This actor found adolescent success after appearing on *Arrested Development* as George Michael Bluth but rose to stardom acting alongside Jonah Hill as Evan. For 10 points, name this Canadian actor known for his work in *Superbad* and *Scott Pilgrim vs. the World*.

ANSWER: Michael <u>Cera</u> (fancam must legally be played afterwards (<u>https://youtu.be/pLgduG0seIo</u>)) <Haylee>

7. This girlfriend-haver came very close to dying in a 2017 Amtrak incident. He is a self proclaimed "megafauna stan" and *Jeopardy!* enjoyer. In one year, this person visited five national parks over spring break. He once played blackjack for more than three hours on a flight from Portland to Heathrow. His girlfriend was the winner of the 2022 (*) Dubs Challenge, which she achieved by "befriending random freshman boys who can run fast." He's not Euan, but this person also has English relatives and hails from Washington state. While suffering from COVID-19 symptoms, this UW quiz bowler read for Canadian Novice. This person has lived in Haggett, Willow, and Mercer. For 10 points, name this UW quiz bowler and trumpet player whose research focuses on modeling hummingbirds and shares a last name with the author of "The Garden Party." ANSWER: Lucas Mansfield

<Phoebe & Henry>

8. In one story, this mother of Telegonus turns the Italian king Picus into a woodpecker for rejecting her advances. Virgil's Aeneid describes her home as sounding like "the roars of lions that refuse the chain, / The grunts of bristled boars, and groans of bears, / And herds of howling wolves that stun the sailors' ears." One of this figure's potions caused dogs to spring from a bather's (*) thighs and turned her into a monster in a famous Greek epic. This creator of Scylla is the daughter of the sun god Helios and a sea nymph. Other hot people in her bloodline include Aeëtes, Pasiphaë, and Medea. She's not Calypso, but this enchantress also lives on an island with a weird name. Madeline Miller published an eponymous 2018 novel about, for 10 points, which woman who turned Odysseus and his men into swine?

ANSWER: Circe

9. This character hides bombs in objects like a present and a basketball. Pink petals fall while this character sings about the forbidden love that they feel for the player. On a restaurant's wall, this character leaves several reviews, including "My face tastes beautiful," referencing a steak that's served there. The player flies upward with their jetpack while dodging (*) cooking ingredients that this character drops. When first meeting this character, they ask the player, "Would you smooch a ghost," to which the answer is "Heck Yeah." In that quiz show segment, this character also presents a math question about two trains, asking how long until they pass each other. This character is the star of the TV show "Cooking with a Killer Robot." For 10 points, name this box-shaped robot built by Alphys, first encountered in the Hotlands.

ANSWER: <u>Mettaton</u> [do not accept "Mettaton EX" or "Mettaton NEO"] <Rosie>

10. In a documentary produced by VICE News, this man recalled that the CEO of Bear Stearns called him on his birthday while he was eating at a Greek restaurant. He reportedly "thought about thinking about" starting a presidential campaign in 2018 and stated that he could beat Donald Trump in an election but ultimately decided against it. In 2005, he became the (*) CEO of what is now the largest bank in America after it merged with Bank One. His pay was cut in half after the 2012 "London Whale" incident that resulted in over \$6 billion in trading losses for that bank. For 10 points, who is the current CEO of JPMorgan Chase? ANSWER: Jamie Dimon [or James Dimon]

11. In one movie, this character makes a deal with the Stabbington Brothers but later betrays them and allows them to get arrested. In the opening to that movie, this character knocks over a basket, causing them to lose access to a magical item. This character tells her adoptive daughter that she should stay in a certain (*) building to avoid things like "poison ivy" and "quicksand" and describes her as "ditzy" and "vague" in a song. A man whose real name is Euguene kills this character by cutting that adoptive daughter's hair before this character falls out a window and turns into dust. For 10 points, name this character, Rapunzel's hot mother who knows best in *Tangled*.

ANSWER: Mother <u>Gothel</u> <Javden>

12. In an interview by *The Standard*, this individual claimed they were either 49 or 47 percent woman, depending on the day. In 2019, Justin Bieber posted results of an ancestry DNA test, where, upon learning this person was his 11th cousin once removed, claimed it was the best day of his life. This performer held vocal and bass guitar duties while in a gothic rock band. While in said rock band, he went by the stage name "Baby Goose." In 2014, Vine user (*) Ryan McHenry uploaded a series of shitposts where this man is fed cereal. Upon McHenry's passing, this man recorded & posted himself eating cereal as a tribute. This actor has inadvertently spawned a series of edits depicting himself, often portraying the condition of male loneliness and isolation. Those edits are most often paired to Simpsonwave1995 or "A Real Hero." In a Jimmy Kimmel interview, this man revealed a main inspiration for taking on a recent role was stepping into his backyard and seeing a depiction of said role face down in the mud next to a squashed lemon. For 10 points, name this Canadian actor and Golden Globe Recipient who besides literally being me, has appeared in *Drive, Blade Runner 2049*, and *Barbie*. ANSWER: Ryan **Gosling** [prompt on me, literally me or other equivalents until read] <Richard>

13. Description acceptable. In one scene, these people are said to resemble Botticelli's *The Birth of Venus* and evoke the goddess of love. In a later scene, these people appear to join a coven and attempt to cast a spell to make someone fall in love with them. One of these people wears a purple outfit and is the only one of her

peers who is not released from her prison in a symbolic and foreshadowing scene. Another one of these people sits and sips wine while watching his co-star climb onto the (*) table and sing about how he only puts up with her love in their theatrical relationship instead of celebrating it. The objectively hottest one of these people has gone viral for his provocative dancing and iconic wink at the end of "Lavender Haze." For 10 points, name this group of people including Raphael Thomas and Jan Ravnik who accompany the artist of songs like "Tolerate It" and "Lover" on her 2023-2024 world tour.

ANSWER: **backup dancers** for Taylor Swift's **Era's Tour** [accept equivalent descriptions; prompt on Taylor Swift's backup dancers by asking "for what event?"; do not accept or prompt on "Taylor Swift"] <Elliana>

14. While this game normally encourages the player to play in a stealthy manner, one section of this game gives her a grenade launcher, something the character also quite clearly enjoys as moves through the Solarii ("SOL-ar-ee") fortress. Under normal gameplay, this character's primary weapon is a bow and arrow, which often starts as one she makes herself and includes arrow types such as explosives, fire, poison gas, and with rope attached. In the first game of this character's rebooted game series, she ends up shipwrecked on the island of (*) Yamatai, which is surrounded by supernatural storms that prevent anyone that lands on the island from leaving. A recurring enemy for this character is the ancient conspiracy Trinity, which aims to control artifacts and shape the world as they see fit. Said group's high council is killed entirely offscreen with no input in the third game of this character's series. One document covers the time this character locked her butler in the freezer, referencing something that could be done in this franchise's original continuity. For 10 points, name this acrobatic archaeologist protagonist of the *Tomb Raider* series.

15. In one tweet, this person said that their Turkish ancestry causes them to grow hair really fast. This person once tweeted that a common question they get is how they do "the :3 ("colon-three") thing with their mouth"; they claimed that it just sits that way naturally. A tweet from this person states that being transgender is a "real joy" and that being around other queer people is a really positive experience. A popular tweet by this person is a picture of herself in the hospital with a caption that implies (*) Hasan Piker is the reason for it, many people reference that tweet in the replies of her other tweets. Her profile icon is inspired by Cabanel's painting *Fallen Angel*. For 10 points, name this trans woman on Twitter with the nickname "estrogen angel." ANSWER: <u>Cloudy</u> [or @oncloud_e] <Rosie>

16. These people were the subject of a November 2021 limited edition BT21 merch collaboration, which was promoted by a claymation trailer. In a manga one-shot written by Berabou [BEH-ra-bow], one of these people dies after making fun of another's fried egg, and another kills himself after part of his hair breaks off. Some of these people's pets include a hamster named Hammy and a one-eyed dog. With the exception of Fortegreen ("FORTE-green"), who weighs 132 pounds, these people weigh (*) 92 pounds. In May 2021, a McDonald's BTS meal included a chicken nugget shaped like one of these people, which sold for 99,997 USD on eBay. A 2022 April Fool's prank involved replacing these people with horse-like creatures. For 10 points, name these characters, who were featured on a viral Twitch stream held to encourage voting in the 2020 election and were played by Ilhan Omar and AOC.

ANSWER: <u>Among Us crewmates</u> [or <u>Among Us impostors</u>; prompt on description of characters from Among Us] <Fish & Shoe>

17. According to the autobiography from the *Player's Tribune* website, this person's parents fought the Spanish law that obligates the paternal surname to be put first. Originally trained in her home province, this player once considered leaving for the United States to continue her professional (*) soccer career but ended up

playing in Europe. She has been in the starting lineup in 4 of 5 most recent UEFA Women's Champions League finals and was named Player of the Match of the final in 2021. For 10 points, name this Barça ("BAR-sah") midfielder who won the FIFA Women's World Cup and the Ballon d'Or Feminin in 2023. ANSWER: Aitana **Bonmati** Conca </br>

18. On a cruise to Japan, this woman jumped into the swimming pool of a ship fully clothed and invited a Congressman to join her, an incident that she later claimed "would only have been outrageous had [she] removed [her] clothes." For unrelated reasons, she was also banned from the White House by two separate presidential administrations. This figure who kept a pet snake named Emily (*) Spinach served as an unofficial political adviser to her father for much of his political career, including during his stint as President of the United States. Though she developed breast cancer twice over her lifetime and received a double mastectomy, this woman managed to be the longest-lived child of a US President, dying at the age of 96 of emphysema and pneumonia. Known for dramatics, it is said she cut her wedding cake with a sword, campaigned against her own husband, and, in the span of 15 months, attended 407 dinners, 350 balls, and 300 parties. For 10 points, name this eldest child of US President Theodore Roosevelt, for whom a shade of blue is named.

ANSWER: <u>Alice Roosevelt</u> Longworth [prompt on "Roosevelt" until read] <Phoebe>

19. Although known for various Mexican films and shows, this actor guest starred as Jack Duquesne ("du-KANE") in Marvel's Hawkeye. A character played by this actor is introduced cooking and jovially singing to loud music in stark contrast to the rest of his infamous family. That same character by this actor (*) interrogates another character about his trip to pick up money repeating the phrase "Tell me again." He later goes to Germany to seduce the wife of the late Werner Ziegler, to uncover a hidden construction project. For 10 points, name the actor who plays Eduardo, a maniacal Salamanca, better known as Lalo in Better Call Saul. ANSWER: Tony Dalton

<Gavin>

20. Despite having access to firearms, this character is able to successfully use a bow and arrow to kill targets who are otherwise wearing extremely effective armor by aiming for gaps in said armor. This character is shown to be willing to bend the rules of the hotel she works at, allowing Nobody to keep his dog in the hotel room. After the hotel's deconsecration by the High Table and the subsequent battle that results in the death of her father, this character vows to (*) John Wick that if he doesn't end up Caine then she will, something she is shown to be trying to do in the post-credits scene of the film she appears in. For 10 points, name this character played by Rina Sawayama who worked as the concierge at the Osaka Continental Hotel in *John Wick: Chapter 4*. ANSWER: <u>Akira</u> Shimazu [accept <u>Osaka Continental concierge</u> before last line]

21. This character's signature drink is a can of 100% caffeine-free "orthodox cola drink" that should be "enjoyed calmly" and is one of six options offered at vending machines. A discarded portrait of this character can be found in a cordoned-off area of a museum, placed next to an easter egg that briefly plays Clair de Lune. In one cutscene, this character's desktop is shown containing a folder containing cat gifs and a window titled "Top 5 ways to make your boss happy." This character's main theme is (*) "Negotiation," the only boss fight theme to be an original composition. In a PA announcement, this character asks why a coffee machine needs a firmware update. An antagonist that attempts to kill this character with a giant laser laments that he did not use a flamethrower, due to this character being fired shortly prior. To S-rank Track 7, this character must be successfully caught during a quick-time event after her boss battle. For 10 points, name this character who has gained a large simp following for her ambiguously Scottish accent and pinkish-red hair, the head of security in *Hi-Fi* ("high-fye") *Rush.*

ANSWER: <u>Korsica</u> <Fish>

22. It's not Euan, but this character claims to hate "kids, animals, and women with attitudes." A grotesque facial expression made by this character appears on the cover of an album that includes the songs "Bad Dog No Biscuits" and "Waltz for Zizi." This character's eyes are said to be different colors even though they are only distinguished in extreme closeups. A forgotten lobster comes back to life to terrorize this character in a spoof of *Alien* which concludes with the lesson, "Don't leave things in the fridge." This (*) Martian shares a name with a previous Hot People Packet answer, a rival of Angel. For 10 points, name this protagonist of the only good anime, a fuzzy-haired cowboy who lives with Edward Wong Hau Pepelu Tivrusky IV on the *Bebop*. ANSWER: Spike <u>Spiegel</u>

<Sonya>

23. This actor received their television debut on the *Law & Order: Criminal Intent* episode "Self-Made," appearing as Chayne Danforth. Nando v Movies selected this actor as his number one pick to play Mr. Fantastic, and later expressed disappointment when this actor appeared as a far more obscure character in the MCU. One character played by this actor is an (*) anthropology student who neglects to inform his friends of the significance of a certain ritual. That character played by this actor is later distracted by someone he believes to be his friend Mark. A different character played by this actor is noted as being from Senegal and speaking French yet speaks French zero times in the series he appears in. For 10 points, name this actor who played Quaz in *Ant-Man and the Wasp: Quantumania*, as well as Chidi in *The Good Place*. ANSWER: William Jackson Harper [accept William Fitzgerald Harper]

<Truman>

24. The menu of the redux version of the series featuring this character shows said character pacing around a room roughly 20 years after the events of the series. This character has an unfortunate habit of being captured, once by communists after a raid on a church, and another time by cannibals in the bunker meant to house the Russian leadership in the event of nuclear war. This character is the daughter of the leader and founder of the Moscow Metro's (*) SPARTA Order and specializes in sniping, which can be less than useful in the cramped tunnels of a metro line. In *Metro: Exodus*, this character falls into a bunker filled with gas from decaying ammunition, severely damaging her lungs and forcing the crew of the Aurora to go to the severely irradiated Novosibirsk to find a cure, an expedition that kills her father in the process. For 10 points, name this *Metro* series sniper and wife of the main character Artyom.

ANSWER: <u>Anna</u> Miller (from *Metro: Exodus*) <Jesse>

25. This character is first seen sitting in the row behind the protagonist in class twirling a golden pen and making incredibly homosexual eye contact that is never addressed. He later approaches that protagonist at a bar and asks him, "Have you figured it out yet?" and when prompted elaborates on "Who the best is." Both him and the protagonist somehow leave this conversation thinking they are, in fact, the best, and will spend the next 90 minutes trying to prove this assumption to the other. This character and his now rival are the only students who successfully take down Jester, though this character's RIO Slider claims that only their victory counts, as the protagonist flew below the hard deck and they did not. Keep in mind that this entire very tense conversation happens in a locker room with very few clothes involved. They'll never beat the allegations, I'm afraid. It wouldn't be a movie from the eighties if there wasn't a weirdly sexual game of beach volleyball and this one doesn't disappoint, as this character sexily spins a volleyball on his finger before he and the protagonist go head to head alongside their respective partners. After the protagonist leaves early to engage in some compulsive heterosexuality with his teacher, this character heckles his rival's RIO, yelling out, "Mother (*) Goose you pussy!" That line ages badly, as that character is later killed in an accident caused by this

character's jet wash, which leads to his rival contemplating dropping out of the Top Gun program. 26. This character's dwelling features background music that is played entirely by a harp. When the player wears a certain scent, this character joyfully recognizes it as one belonging to a former friend. A knight lost her life to defend this character against a band of traitors, and her corpse is found outside this character's dwelling. Because this character has become blind and does not leave their dwelling, they are unaware of (*) Dryya's death. In one line of dialogue, this character describes her "voracious desire to spread seeds upon the land" and "to breed." She is found after killing the Traitor Lord, and many corpses of mantis traitors are seen outside her dwelling. She helped create all of the Vessels, with the exception of Hornet. This character resembles a tree, and branches can be seen growing out of her cocoon-like dwelling. For 10 points, name this former Queen of Hallownest, the wife of the Pale King who gives the player half of the Kingsoul charm.

ANSWER: White Lady

27. This lead singer of a Canadian indie rock band spent two years living in a loft in Brooklyn with people that would later go on to be members of groups such as Yeah Yeah Yeahs and TV on the Radio. This singer has also collaborated with Broken Social Scene, notably contributing vocals for their album *Lover's Spit* and the song "Anthems for a Seventeen-Year-Old Girl." The appearance of Envy Adams from (*) *Scott Pilgrim* is partly based on this singer, whose band also contributed the song "Black Sheep" for the film adaptation. Albums by the band fronted by this singer included *Grow Up and Blow Away, Synthetica, Formentera*, and *Fantasies*. For 10 points, name this lead singer of Metric.

ANSWER: Emily <u>Haines</u> <Jesse>

28. The opening song of a musical states that this character "is hot" while another character "is a slut." This character originates in a novel which is frequently referenced in the Peanuts franchise. In the musical, this character is portrayed by Lucas Steele, whose performance was inspired by David Bowie. In one song, this character longs for "her arms, her shoulders, her neck, her feet" in reference to a character who was once portrayed by (*) Audrey Hepburn. In the novel, this character is forgiven by Andrei, which does not prevent this character's leg from being sawn off. For 10 points, name this no-good Russian aristocrat, the brother of Pierre's wife Helene and the son of Vasili Kuragin in *War & Peace*.

ANSWER: <u>Anatole</u> Kuragin [prompt on <u>Kuragin</u> until read] <Sonya>

29. This man describes himself as a very amateur guitarist and has recorded three singles, including "Lip Service," which can be listened to on Spotify. In September 2023, this man launched the Global Music Diplomacy Initiative, at which he played and sang Muddy Waters' "Hoochie Coochie Man." He's not really a world leader, but he appears in a video titled "Surprising World Leaders By Speaking Their Languages," in which he speaks French. Despite condemning the genocide in Gaza, this man said in an October meeting with the Israeli prime minister that "as long as (*) America exists... we will always be there, by your side." He has condemned the ethnic cleansings in China and Ethiopia and has made several trips to Ukraine. In his first year in his current position, this man rejected the hierarchy of rights presented in the Commission on Unalienable Rights, headed by his predecessor Mike Pompeo. For 10 points, name this current United States Secretary of State. ANSWER: Antony <u>Blinken</u> <Rosie>

30. In one movie, this person appears in a fourth-wall-breaking segment where they explain mortgage bonds. A character played by this person has their life spared when Tex changes his plans and breaks into the house next door, intending to kill Cliff Booth. In another movie, this person exclaims "you killed my sandwich" before kicking a woman through a window. One movie depicts an alternate history in which the Manson family are unsuccessful in killing (*) Sharon Tate, who is played by this person. This person's costars in one movie include Ewan McGregor, who plays the villain Roman Sionis; that movie is *Birds of Prey*. In a recent movie, this person plays a character who is told to "get in the box" at Mattel's headquarters. For 10 points, name this Australian actress whose roles include Harley Quinn and Barbie.

ANSWER: Margot Robbie

31. Note to players: you already know who wrote this, have fun! A 1968 "Forward Thrust" ballot measure would have built something resembling this system but failed to gain the required supermajority. One product used by this system is made by Kinki Sharyo and is known for its rounded design and overall inferiority to the S500 that succeeded it. One member of UW Quizbowl once described part of this system as "made by a drunk toddler" for its low catchment area. (*) Bruce Harrell proposed a controversial "Shifted West" location for one part of this system, which will be single-tracking in January for repairs to its Downtown Transit Tunnel. This system will open a "starter line" on the Eastside before its full East Extension in 2025. For 10 points, name this second-hottest light rail system on the West Coast, which currently runs from Angle Lake to Northgate in the greater Seattle region.

ANSWER: <u>Link</u> Light Rail <Catherine>

32. This person solicited drummer Stevo Jocz ("YOH-tch") to record parts for the songs "contagious" and "one of those girls" after he requested only a black bean burrito as compensation and then proceeded to mess up his order. Her most famous album includes the singles (*) "Hot," "When you're gone," and a chart-topping hit whose music video became the first to surpass 100 million views on youtube. She sang her newest single live in a recent surprise appearance with All Time Low in Las Vegas as well as her legendary hit "sk8er boi." For 10 points, name this Canadian Queen of pop-punk, who clearly doesn't like your girlfriend.

33. This man persuaded Eduardo Ribera to start a company to manufacture a signature good specially for him. It's not David Bowie, but in 1983, this man's iconic style earned him a spot in the Fashion Hall of Fame by People Magazine. This politician wore MINFAR dress for much of his career but later would switch to wearing (*) tracksuits, including famously at a meeting with Pope Francis. He was not American, but was often seen wearing a ridgeway cap following a revolution. This man gave examples of his signature accessory to political leaders, and the United States attempted to assassinate him with an exploding version. For 10 points, name this Cuban revolutionary and leader, known for his rough beard and signature cigar.

34. This person claims that she was bullied for her appearance when she lived in Arlington, Virginia. In 2019, the New York Post published a story about a woman who claimed that "My husband dumped me for" this person. This politician was sworn in on the (*) Quran after winning an election in the fifth congressional district of that state. For 10 points, name this first Somali American member of Congress who currently represents Minneapolis in the House of Representatives.

35. Character and specified depiction required. This character discovers Amazo upon finding Professor Ivo dead. This man later teams up with Ray Palmer in order to prevent Amazo's return to earth. In his first appearance, this character's mech suit is "hijacked" by mercenaries, though it is later shown that this character willingly gave the suit to Kaznia. This character indirectly causes Billy Batson's true form to be revealed during a scheme he devised involving a campaign for (*) U.S. President. After discovering he has cancer, this man recruits The Shade, Star Sapphire, and several others into the first Injustice Gang. An alternate version of this man unwittingly creates the Justice Lords after executing the Flash and himself being killed by the heat vision of a certain Kryptonian. For 10 points, name this Clancy Brown-voiced supervillain, a traditional foe of Superman.

ANSWER: Lex Luthor in the DCAU [accept either underlined portion; accept equivalent descriptions; accept Justice League; Justice League: Unlimited, or Superman: the Animated Series for "DCAU" until read; prompt on partial answers; Prompt on DC Universe; do not accept or prompt on any other DC universe because his VA isn't goated in the other ones]

36. The August 2016 issue of *Lego Club* magazine listed this character as being in a romantic relationship with another character but a correction in the next issue said that they are actually best friends. Although this character has a canonical appearance, their skin and hair were made slightly darker in one spin-off, and alternate depictions of them include a dark-skinned tennis player and a blond-haired blue-eyed Swede. This character is often thought to be gender-neutral due to a 2012 creator post confirming that (*) gender does not exist in-universe. However, that post pre-dates the 2014 release of this character, who is canonically female and was at least partially designed for increased female representation in gaming. Until seven new default characters were introduced in October 2022, this character was one of two default characters whose models only differed by the width of their arms. 38. Note to players: This tossup will be read to the end without interruption. In a meeting with Mao Zedong, this person replied, "It is such a novel proposition, we will have to study it" after Mao offered ten million Chinese women. Despite being a Jewish refugee who escaped Nazi Germany, this person said, "any people who has been persecuted for 2000 years must be doing something wrong." This person supported (*) Mobutu Sese Seko ("SAY-say SAY-ko") and the apartheid government of South Africa in his efforts to quell the uprisings in Angola. Because of this man's policy of bombing Cambodia, Anthony Bourdain once wrote that he wanted to "beat [this person] to death with his bare hands." This former secretary of state received a Nobel Peace Prize for negotiating the end of the Vietnam War. For 10 points, name this hot person who is currently burning in hell. ANSWER: Henry Kissinger

39. During a tense scene, this non-religious character whispers, "God, please" before firing a shot. This character, who a phrenology-obsessed man describes as "paedomorphic," suggests that the next racist he meets will grant him and another character three wishes. This RCM officer can be convinced to dance inside an abandoned church, but he will never kiss another character. This character considers himself a true Revacholian ("re-vuh-SHO-lee-an") even though two of his grandparents come from (*) Seol ("SEE-ol"). Seol is a fictional country, but this character's first name is a common Korean surname. For 10 points, name this best written character in any video game, a lieutenant who serves as the protagonist's partner in *Disco Elysium*. ANSWER: <u>Kim Kitsuragi</u> [accept either underlined portion] <Sonya>

40. In 2009, this actor guest starred on *Pozner* as an interviewee. As of now, this actor has been in 113 episodes of *Bild Live*, a tabloid German news show. A polyglot and writer, this person speaks 9 languages fluently along with writing novels like *Time and People, Feather of the Black Vulture*. This person's regional birthplace is included in the title of a documentary of that country's president visiting that region. That film is about (*) Russian president Vladimir Putin fishing in Tuva. For 10 points, name this Russian Minister of Defence. ANSWER: Sergei Kuzhugetovich Shoigu <Gavin>

41. For Christmas 2021, this person appeared in a McDonald's commercial where they serve Mariah Carey dipping sauce on a tray. In 2022, this person appeared alongside Paula Abdul at the Macy's Thanksgiving Day Parade on a float designed like a giant golden turkey. This person won two awards for best dancer in (*) Slovenia and worked as a choreographer with the Slovenian Olympic committee. In one number, this person wears a puffy red vest and red pants, while in another he stares at the audience while dancing behind a purple ladder. For 10 points, give the name of this dancer, who holds an umbrella over Taylor Swift's on the Eras Tour. ANSWER: Jan Ravnik [accept either underlined portion; accept descriptions of the really hot dancer from the Eras Tour movie until read] <Jayden>

42. You may find this character to be suspicious of a certain pigeon, who is voiced by the same actor as his ultimate enemy. If your dream is to be like Mary Shelley, then you should attempt to romance this character, as success will allow you to fuck him on his own grave, though ironically, his eventual aversion to sex resulting from a history of abuse has actually made this character a favorite among asexual fans in addition to you horny motherfuckers. The song "I Want to Live" by Borislav Slavov, which can be heard at multiple points in the background of the game in which this character appears, is his unofficial theme and can be found in the Spotify playlist his voice actor created for him. If you encounter a monster hunter while traveling with this character, he will ask for your permission to kill them and will disapprove if you say no. That monster hunter

45. This character's attempts at using a dating service are documented in a dossier in a DLC for the game this character appears in. All of the entries related to this end in her abruptly disconnecting. The player's first introduction to this non-villain character involves her shooting someone that had been your squadmate for the opening mission of this series' second mainline game. This character's first appearance in the series was actually in a 2009 game for iOS, *Mass Effect* (*) *Galaxies*. This character, modeled after and voiced by Yvonne Strahovski, is a heavily genetically modified opposite sex clone of an extremely wealthy, extremely egotistical businessman. Depending on player choices, this character may also kill said businessman without much compunction in *Mass Effect 3*. 48. In an outtake that made the official blooper reel for its show, this person threw a flashlight and hit their castmate in the face. In the press for that same show, this person stated that they used to perform autopsies on dead lizards and other animals found in their backyard. Another character played by this person has the instagram handle @ellie-eyeballs, which could be a nod to her well-established horror persona in real life. One of this actress' first roles was the (*) younger version of Gina Rodriguez' character on *Jane the Virgin*, which she struggled to land due to there being few roles for Latinas in Hollywood. This actress resigned from the cast of *Scream* 7 shortly after her castmate Melissa Barrerra was fired for protesting the Israel-Palestine conflict. For 10 points, name this Mexican and Puerto-Rican successor of Christina Ricci who went viral for a dance she choreographed herself in *Wednesday*.
