2. When asked how he stole a heavily guarded piece of technology, this character responds that "you just walk in like you belong". This character is taken by his adoptive mother after witnessing a member of his tribe be killed by a survivor of a ship crash. Timm Karlo rats out this character after seeing a request for tips on a Kenari male. Two Pre-Mor Security Inspection Team guards are killed by this man in his first appearance in a show. This character is forced to abandon Kino Loy on Narkina 5 after the latter reveals (*) he can't swim. Luthen Rael attempts to recruit this man by asking him if he would "like to fight these bastards for real". This character is killed while he hugs Jyn Erso on a beach. For 10 points, name this rebel captain who serves as the male lead of *Rogue One* and the main protagonist of an eponymous Disney+ series.

3. This artist made a last-minute decision to cancel their show on October 11, 2023 in Newport, Ohio in order to perform on the Tonight Show with Jimmy Fallon, attracting controversy from fans. This singer released the mini-album Euphoric Sad Songs through Polydor Records, but later revealed the record label had been withholding her debut album for years, which influenced her decision to go independent. This singer was the musical guest on a Kristen Wiig-hosted episode of SNL in 2024, performing her recently trending song "Worth It.". A 2023 remix of this singer's song "Ferrari Horses" charted higher in the UK than the original single. That remix was created by the DJ Cassö and was titled (*) "Prada". For 10 points, what British singer is known for her debut album My 21st Century Blues 2023 and is responsible for the hit song "Escapism"? ANSWER: <u>RAYE</u> (accept <u>Rachel</u> Agatha <u>Keen</u>) <Anirudh>

4. A song off of this musician's first album begins [read slowly] "short D, E, F, E, long D, short E, F". This musician was picked up by Olivia Rodrigo's current producer in 2020, but was dropped from Atlantic in August of the same year. This singer took her stage name to honor her (*) grandfather and his favorite Marty Robbins song. One music video from this singer uses a man-eating siren as an metaphor for a partner who won't commit, singing "Knee deep in the passenger seat and you're eating me out / Is it casual now?" For 10 points, name this Missourian singer-songwriter that Ella listened to 69 times in one day. ANSWER: Chappell Roan (score clue from "Femininomenon," lyric from "Casual")

5. This character has the name "Esmeralda" engraved on both sides of her motorcycle, and used to be one of Nicoletta's best repeat customers when she ran a weapons shop in Fortuna. This character inherited heterochromia from her father and has been played by several voice actors including Kari Wahlgren and Kate Higgins. This character is only slightly younger than (*) Dante, meaning that she is in her mid-40s in Devil May Cry 5, where her render is based off of british actress Andrea Tivadar. For 10 points, name this thirteenth boss of Devil May Cry 3, a bazooka-wielding demon hunter on a vendetta against her father Arkham.

ANSWER: <u>Lady</u> (accept <u>Mary</u>) <Ali>

6. In a short blurb for *The New Yorker*, this person's mother, who was formerly known as a professional clown named Bonabini, claims that his birth felt like "trying to shit out a watermelon." In this person's only voice acted role, he portrays a character named Tyler Gunderson who is tackled off a tree by his girlfriend(*) Jewel in their first encounter. Woody Harrelson starred along this man in two different franchises, into one of which he was "lured" by this man over dinner. In one of those franchises, both this actor and Woody Harrelson play characters named after cities in the U.S. who embark on a roadtrip across the country. Ironically, this person does not have a Facebook account and did not know of Facebook until 2009, just before he received his most iconic role in *The Social Network*. While in the Stratford Tower, this character can be physically traumatized by having his heart ripped out and his hand pinned to a countertop, or mentally traumatized by being connected to Simon when he dies. This character's partner is driven to commit suicide if this character repeatedly dies, as it reminds his partner of the death of his son Cole. This character's first chapter opens with him playing with a (*) quarter coin on the way to a hostage situation, and the first choice he can make is whether or not to save a fish. Another character played by this actress became the laughingstock of the whole town after saving her father's life by mouth-to-mouth resuscitation at a waterpark. Over a decade earlier, this actress came up with the idea for an episode in which that same character gets a makeover, requesting the showrunners to (*) "get the condom hat off her head". This actress tore a ligament during the four months of heavy dieting and ballet training she underwent for the film Black Swan. For 10 points, name this Ukrainian born actress famous for playing Jackie Burkhart and Meg Griffin since 1999 ANSWER: Milena Markovna "Mila" Kunis <Ali>

9. The rift between Starr Carter and a character played by this personality is exacerbated when Hailey Grant unfollows Starr on Tumblr after she shares the story of Emmett Till. Waxen candles, yellow frosted flowers, and close friends surround an image of this enchantress posted on Reddit as an incarnation of Leonardo diCaprio pleads with her to not turn 25 because "your [sic] so sexy aha". Humor, energy, and a perceived genuineness are key traits this interviewee of People magazine prescribed to any potential suitors, the most successful of which as of 2024 remains Barry (*) Keoghan. This media star's proclivity towards fake tanning, being 5 feet tall, and only writing songs about sex led to many on Twitter characterizing her as a "horny Oompa Loompa". For ten points, the methylxanthine class of central nervous system stimulants is a key aesthetic concept which renders what singer's boy unable to sleep in the 2024 breakout single "Espresso"?

10. This celebrity's face was sliced in a wakeboarding accident, leaving a scar near her left eye - a feature she has in common with the writer of this question. One character played by this actress recites 1 Corinthians 13:4-8 as she is executed for infidelity along with her secret lover Isaac. This actress graduated valedictorian of her high school and was bitten by a huntsman spider while portraying an adaptation of (*) Beatrice Messina from Shakespeare's "Much Ado About Nothing". This actress hosted SNL in March 2024 with musical guest Kacey Musgraves, playing a Hooters Waitress in one skit. For 10 points, name this Washington-born actress who was catapulted into fame in 2023 after starring in "Anyone But You" opposite Glen Powell. ANSWER: Sydney <u>Sweeney</u>

11. Description acceptable. This person goes on a tangent to explain how a discovery by Arnold Shapiro was refined by people like Bernard Moran and Bill Thurston. This person gloats about how her ideas are rattling around "inside that dumb, caveman-like brain of yours" in an extended rant dedicated to roasting her male counterpart. This person clears her throat loudly after being asked "if I were able to sharply bend you, could we turn you into less of a bitch?". This person is mocked as "the overlord of science and geometry" after using a (*) monorail to explain the "Turning Number". A shocking plot twist reveals that this person not only had an affair with her co-presenter but that they were also siblings. This person appears in a Huggabees video that parodies her appearance in a math video with a retro purple and yellow aesthetic. For ten points, name this person who works with her male partner to try to invert a round object in a viral YouTube video. ANSWER: the <u>woman</u> from <u>turning a sphere inside out</u> (accept the <u>woman</u> from <u>turning a sphere outside in</u> and

other equivalents, accept Kylie <u>Rutzen</u>, accept Judith <u>Bregmann</u>) <Kevin>

12. This character finished 7th at EVO 2023 and was played by Zando before he switched to Asuka R. Kreutz. This character first began to understand humanity upon tasting a hamburger from Danny Missiles, given to her by Sin Kiske. Her left arm and leg are covered in (*) red bandages following the incident at Scandiva and her current theme song "Necessary Discrepancy" succeeds "Diva of Despair" from Guilty Gear Xrd (pronounced "ZERD"). Her Bajoneto attack launches swords to pressure and corner opponents, rendering her slash and heavy slash attacks temporarily inaccessible. For 10 points, name this older sister of Elphelt Valentine who was created in opposition to humanity, declaring that "the future of mankind… is the past". ANSWER: <u>Ramlethal</u> Valentine (prompt on <u>Valentine</u>) <Ali>

13. A hot painter with this first name takes the protagonist to her log cabin in *Kiki's Delivery Service*. An author with this first name wrote a book about a mage who seeks to free himself from his own shadow, which was notable for having a dark-skinned protagonist. Another person with this name was the first woman to serve as Germany's Secretary of Defense and presided over the annexation of Crimea. That person with this first name is the current head of the (*) European Union. Perhaps the most famous bearer of this name wrote about an interstellar communication device called the ansible in her Hainish Cycle, and she also wrote about a paradise that relies on the torture of an innocent child. For ten points, give this first name of the sci-fi author of "The Ones Who Walked Away from Omelas".

14. *Description acceptable*. One person remarks "no matter how ornate the grandfather clock is, the pendulum draws the eye" in response to this characteristic presenting an unexpected advantage. However,

this characteristic has also presented disadvantages, most notably when a person lost a hanging weighing-scale hook by accidentally attaching it onto themself. One person's justification of this characteristic was that it inserted a veil between their on-screen personality and their real-life stand-up comedy personality. That person was Nick Mohammed. 15. At the end of the movie in which she appears, this character says "You know the best thing about the future? It hasn't happened yet!" After learning about how people use the van der Waals force to climb walls, this person asks "How would you know if you could climb a wall if you've never tried?". This character tries to protect Julia Cornwall, who is played by (*) Sydney Sweeney. A member of Las Arañas confusingly tells this character "when you take on the responsibility, great power will come". This character questions Ezekiel Sims with the infamous line "He was in the Amazon with my mom when she was researching spiders right before she died." For ten points, name this subject of a 2024 superhero box office bomb.

ANSWER: <u>Madame Webb</u> (accept <u>Cassie Webb</u>, prompt on <u>Dakota Johnson</u>) <Kevin>

16. In an interview about her upcoming directorial debut, this person says that "I think people would want to see that, but then...I think maybe people wanna watch movies about, like, Jesus and dogs." Her previous directorial projects include a short film that premiered in March 2023 and follows the tour of an American indie rock supergroup. In 2017, this person addressed (*) a former president in her coming out monologue, claiming that "if you didn't like me then, you're really probably not going to like me now, because I'm hosting 'SNL' and I'm like, *so* gay, dude." This person's recent roles most notably include a piece in which her character nonchalantly strangles a lesbian to death and leaves her body at the side of the road. *Boygenius: The Film* is directed by, for ten points, which actress who is famously asked, "Where the hell have you been, *loca*?" in the *Twilight* series?

17. He's not Patrick Bateman, but this person once asserted that "real sigmas do coke" during a discussion about hotboxing. This person's hatred of engineers may stem from an incident in the sixth grade where he fell off a bridge and purportedly almost drowned. On one occasion, a Californian attempted to name every trans (*) woman in Quiz Bowl for a question whose answer was actually this person; that Californian is Gavin Morrow. Rumor has it this person once wrote erotic fanfiction for an animated series created by ND Stevenson, a myth that has yet to be confirmed. Some variants on this person's appearance include a shirt bearing a Haruki Murakami quote and merch of American rock band Car Seat Headrest. For ten points, name this avid fan of English singer-songwriter Charli XCX, an infrequently sober Quizbowler who once said his liver could "beat up all of yours." ANSWER: <u>Ben</u>jamin Shi

Yekaterina Lisina is this type of person. One person of this type was raised by Mormons, before designing costumes for eyes wide shut, and later marrying Mick Jagger, that person is L'Wren Scott. Another person of this type played Captain Phasma in Star Wars: The Force Awakens, and later played Lucifer in Netflix's 2021 adaptation of Lucifer. One person of this type set a Pac-10 Conference record for scoring, rebounding and blocking then became the first player in their league's history to (*) dunk during an official game. A fictional person of this type who debuted in 2021, "is said to have generated some interest in trampling" according to wikipedia, and was explained by writer Gemma Glitter in the context of macrophilia. The difficult techniques required to cross a sandy valley successfully are almost mansplained to this character when their companion explains that imperial anthropologists had already documented all of their people's practices centuries earlier. Depictions of this character and their companion were added as Outfits in popular battle royale shooter Fortnite after a 21st century reboot featuring them brought in over \$400 million. A psychoactive command forces this character to mix their tears with a blue secretion (*), reviving the last male descendant of the hereditary rulers of Caladan. Visions induced by the awareness spectrum narcotic Spice in the son of Duke Leto Atreides feature this woman prominently, including scenes of her blood-soaked hands and dagger. For ten points, what daughter of Imperial Planetologist Liet-Kynes is seen fiercely opposing the Bene Gesserit imposed mythology of the Lisan al-Gaib while simultaneously falling in love with Paul Atreides in Denis Villeneuve's Dune and Dune 2?

This actor played Ian in the 2013 film *Adoration*(or *Adore*in most English-speaking countries besides Australia). Cass Chaplin, son of Charlie Chaplin, is played by this actor in the 2022 film *Blonde*. Another character played by this actor is killed by Seth Clearwater during a fight in which he is betrayed by a woman he thought loved him. That character played by this actor is the first "newborn" from Seattle and is tasked by (*) Victoria to create a vampire army. For 10 points, name this Australian actor of Riley Biers in *The Twilight Saga: Eclipse*. ANSWER: Xavier <u>Samuel</u>

21. This person's book of poems "Eat the World" is slated to come out later this year in October. In that book, this person describes the episode in her life that brought her to Hollywood as a bulimic college dropout. Her sophomore album shares a name with an alter ego (*) she created as the "antithesis of herself," supposedly inspired by Aristotle's *Poetics*. This person who is not Catherine Zeta ["ZEE-tah"] rebranded in 2019, before the release of an album that includes a collaboration with Luis Fonsi and Clean Bandit—that album is *Love* + *Fear*. For ten points, name this Welsh singer whose song "How to Be a Heartbreaker" features her iconic cheekbone heart tattoo, and who is now separated from "the Diamonds."

In a 1991 film, a character played by this actor mumbles "I love you and you don't (*) pay me" while staring into a campfire. This actor, in that same role, returns to the United States after his best friend and crush, portrayed by Keanu Reeves, falls in love with an Italian woman. In his breakout role, this actor plays a best friend to Gordie, who he encourages to write "about guys like us, if you ever get hard up for material." This actor famously passed away after overdosing on a combination of heroin and cocaine in West Hollywood's The Viper Room. 23. This man rates the Iraq War three out of five stars after somebody assumes he is in the military. In another scene, this man is attacked by an offensively-named assassin who attempts to cut out his tongue with a hunting knife. After this character is arrested, the film he appears in proposes the ACAB alternative of "Literally Every Cop Except One is in the Pocket of the Mob". After his attempt to leave a voicemail is interrupted, this character is suddenly reminded of his (*) welcome mat. This man utters the phrase "Thank you, Wiccan Tumblr" after trapping an adversary in a protection circle made of cocaine. This one-time real estate lawyer was made into a familiar whose powers stem from eating bugs, and is the servant of a certain count played by Nicolas Cage. For 10 points, name this assistant to Dracula who is played by Nicholas Hoult, the title character of a 2023 film.

When filming an advertisement, this character refuses to do their iconic thumbs up. After getting their finger bit off this character says "Now that right there is the closest thing we've had to an honest exchange so far". This character confronts Bud Askins for working at a company that made faulty T-45 (*) Power Armor. For 10 points, name this Fallout TV Series protagonist who has lived since before the Great War? ANSWER: Cooper Howard (Accept The Ghoul)

25. One character portrayed by this actress holds "Jakey Lady-hands" at gunpoint during Season 2 of Brooklyn Nine-Nine. This person accidentally said the word "fucking" during their debut appearance on *Saturday Night Live*, and was fired at the end of the season, albeit for unrelated reasons. Mona-Lisa, twin sister of Jean-Ralphio Saperstein, is played by this actress on *Parks & Recreation*. This man got his breakout film role after they passed over another actor for being "too good-looking." Despite winning seven awards for that role, this man was nominated for Worst Supporting Actor in 2010. While filming this man's directorial debut

on an isolated island in (*) Indonesia, this man got an eye infection from crawling across a bathroom floor and broke his hand during the first action shot. This man joined the cast of Wes Anderson's The Wonderful Story of Henry Sugar where his character unconventionally read the stage directions within the script aloud. How can we talk about hot people without discussing heat itself? For 10 points each, answer the following questions about thermodynamics.
