

RHSA Organic Act 0708-005

WHEREAS, there are certain areas of the RHSA Bylaws that are unclear and vague, and

WHEREAS, changes within the structural workings of RHSA have led to discontinuities between the RHSA Bylaws and the practices of the general body, and

BE IT RESOLVED, that the RHSA Bylaws be amended in the following manner:

- RHSA Bylaws ARTICLE II SECTION 1F1 shall read as “The purpose shall be to provide a forum for residents to express their programming ideas”

- RHSA Bylaws ARTICLE II SECTION 3D shall read as “D. Constitution and Bylaws Review Committee”

**Comment [AJC2]:** Inserted to uphold current traditions

- RHSA Bylaws ARTICLE II SECTION 3D2d shall read as “Reviewing all hall council constitutions to insure compliance with the RHSA constitution and bylaws by the end of winter quarter”

**Comment [AJC3]:** Changed from “fall” in order to maintain compliance with RHSA Resolution 0607-008

- RHSA Bylaws ARTICLE III SECTION 2C2 shall read as “Discussion is then open to all members for questions of intent and clarification”

**Comment [AJC4]:** Added to clarify current practices

- RHSA Bylaws ARTICLE IV SECTION 1B1 shall read as “The number of present RHSA representatives must be no less than 2/3 plus one of the occupied RHSA representative seats of Hall Councils in good standing”

**Comment [AJC5]:** Added ‘of Hall Councils in good standing’

- RHSA Bylaws ARTICLE IV SECTION 2 shall read as  
“SECTION 2: VOTER ELIGIBILITY

A. All members of RHSA in good standing including Resident Advisers shall have the right to vote on all issues, except in cases explicitly stated in the RHSA Constitution and Bylaws

B. Resident Advisers may not vote on any financial issues”

- RHSA Bylaws ARTICLE IV SECTION 5A shall read as “The Constitution and Bylaws Review Committee answers all questions of interpretation”

**Comment [AJC8]:** Added For Consistency

- RHSA Bylaws ARTICLE IV SECTION 5C shall read as “If there is ever a disagreement between the RHSA Constitution and Bylaws and the Sturgis Standard Code of Parliamentary Procedure, the RHSA Constitution and Bylaws takes precedence”
