Code of Conduct

The Washington State Model United Nations is committed to providing an atmosphere in which all participants can use information and skills to effectively represent their countries in civilized debate. In order to make sure this is possible, the University of Washington's committee chair and the World Affairs Council have established the following Code.

As a delegate to the Washington Model United Nations, I understand that:

- 1) I will observe the schedule of events, including the location of meetings distributed at each meeting.
- 2) I will stay in the University of Washington Student Union Center (HUB).
- 3) I will attend the session to which I am assigned, and remain in that session until recess or adjournment.
- 4) I will wear the badge to identifying my country at all times, and will not modify my badge in any way.
- 5) I will treat all people with respect and dignity.
- 6) I will not pass personal messages of any sort during meetings.
- 7) I will refrain from the use of tobacco, alcohol, and drugs, and will not bring any type of weapon (including toys or fakes) to any of the MUN sessions.
- 8) I will comply with the instructions of the WASMUN and University of Washington staff who are responsible for enforcing this Code.

Washington State Model United Nations Delegate Expectations:

- We expect all participants to read and understand the provisions of the Code.
- Failure to sign the Code will result in a student not being able to participate.
- Students who do not observe the Code will give up their privileges (speaking, voting, etc); in serious cases, a student may be removed from the meeting.
