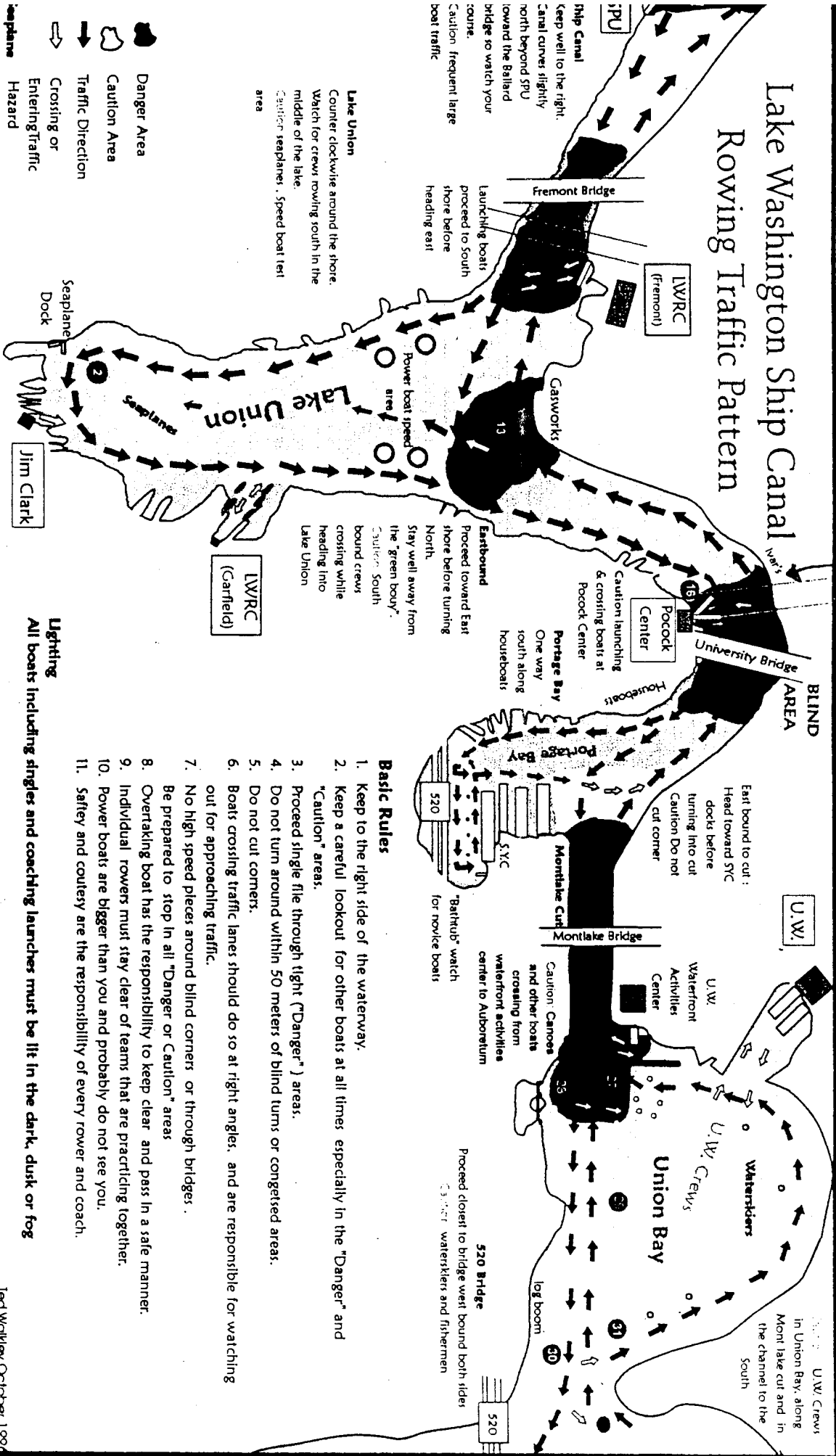




# Lake Washington Ship Canal Rowing Traffic Pattern



\*STAY TO THE LEFT (NORTH) OF THIS RED BUOY BY THE POCOCK CENTER

- Danger Area
- Caution Area
- Traffic Direction
- Crossing or Entering Traffic
- Hazard

**Lake Union**  
 Counter clockwise around the shore.  
 Watch for crews rowing south in the middle of the lake.  
 Caution: seaplanes. Speed boat tail area

**Eastbound**  
 Proceed toward East shore before turning North.  
 Stay well away from the "green buoy".  
 Caution: South bound crews crossing while heading into Lake Union

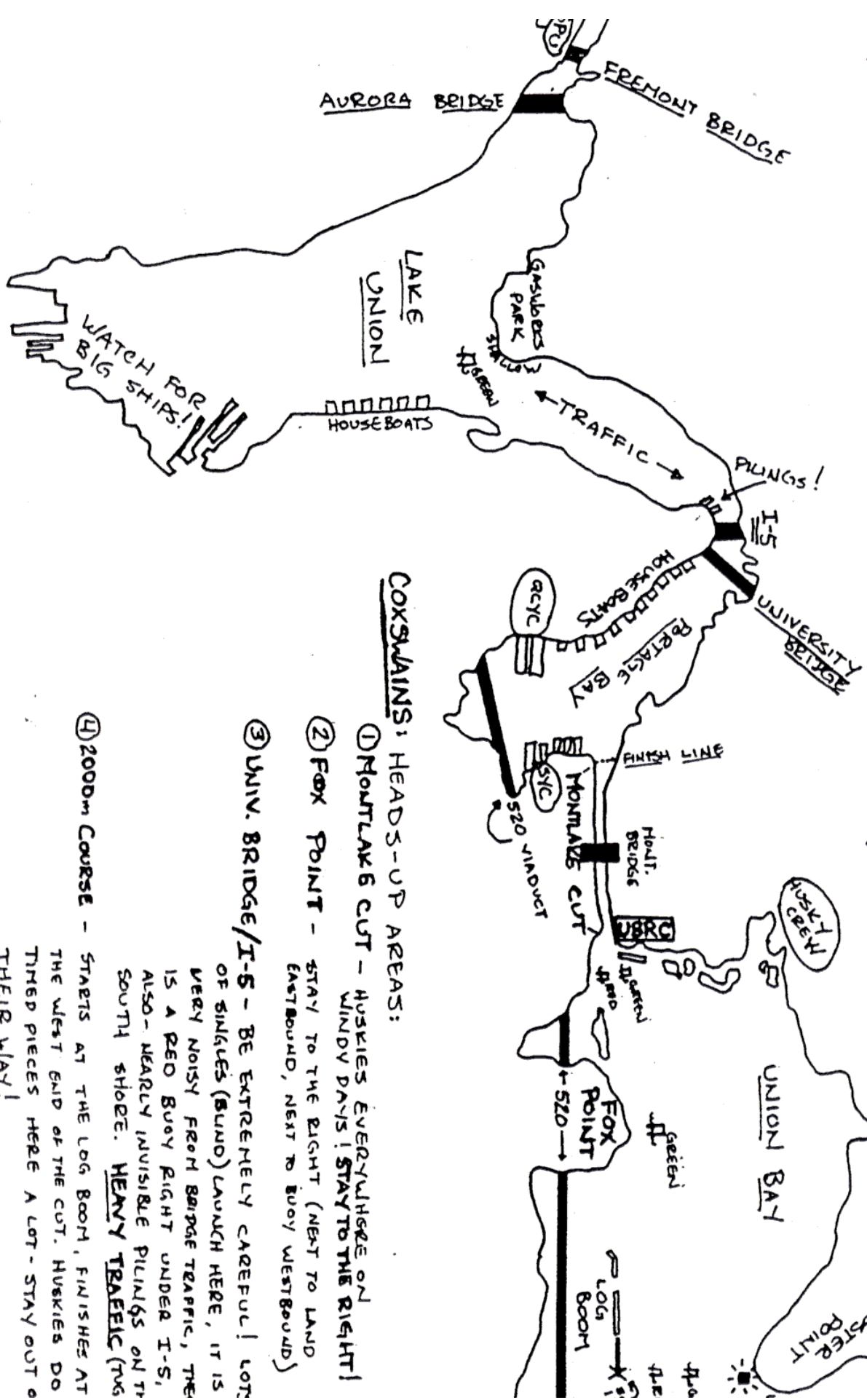
**East bound to cut:**  
 Head toward SYC docks before turning into cut  
 Caution Do not cut corner

### Basic Rules

1. Keep to the right side of the waterway.
2. Keep a careful lookout for other boats at all times; especially in the "Danger" and "Caution" areas.
3. Proceed single file through tight ("Danger") areas.
4. Do not turn around within 50 meters of blind turns or congested areas.
5. Do not cut corners.
6. Boats crossing traffic lanes should do so at right angles, and are responsible for watching out for approaching traffic.
7. No high speed pieces around blind corners or through bridges.
8. Be prepared to stop in all "Danger" or "Caution" areas.
9. Overtaking boat has the responsibility to keep clear and pass in a safe manner.
10. Individual rowers must stay clear of teams that are practicing together.
11. Power boats are bigger than you and probably do not see you.
12. Safety and courtesy are the responsibility of every rower and coach.

**Lighting**  
 All boats including singles and coaching launches must be lit in the dark, dusk or fog

COXSAINS: HEADS-UP AREAS:

- ① MOUNTAIN CUT - HUSKIES EVERYWHERE ON WINDY DAYS! STAY TO THE RIGHT!
- ② FOX POINT - STAY TO THE RIGHT (NEXT TO LAND EASTBOUND, NEXT TO BUOY WESTBOUND)
- ③ UNIV. BRIDGE/I-5 - BE EXTREMELY CAREFUL! LOT OF SINGLES (SUND) LAUNCH HERE, IT IS VERY NOISY FROM BARGE TRAFFIC, THE IS A RED BUOY RIGHT UNDER I-5, ALSO - NEARLY INVISIBLE PILING'S ON THE SOUTH SHORE. HEAVY TRAFFIC (THE)
- ④ 2000m COURSE - STARTS AT THE LOG BOOM, FINISHES AT THE WEST END OF THE CUT. HUSKIES DO THEM PIECES HERE A LOT - STAY OUT OF THEIR WAY!
